Uffculme Green Group complained about single use plastic water bottles being given out. Gary Berry stated that a lot of festivals are plastic free zones now. Suggestion to liaise with the Uffculme Green Group next year.

It was a good idea to rope of the classic cars egress at the conclusion of their event.
